

## Falmouth, Pa. commends sister town Falmouth Virginia Firefighters on heroic act

Recently Captain James Kelley and Sgt. Virgil Bloom, Falmouth Virginia Firefighters were first to respond to a call of a child having a seizure, took the situation into their own hands and used common sense to aid and assist. According to her father Brian Nunamaker, "They simply had the best interests for our daughter's care in mind."

Kelley said they were initially suspended because their fire engine is licensed as a "non-transport unit" and doesn't have the proper restrains and medications that an ambulance would have. He said when this kind of thing happens firefighters are praised, but then disciplined. The two firefighters have been reinstated to serve.

Nancy-Putt Hower, President, The Falmouth Civic Association said "we join with Conoy Township supervisors in sending a letter of support for these 2 firefighters in our sister town of Falmouth Virginia.

Along with the letter Kelley and Sgt. Virgil Bloom also they will receive items from the Falmouth Goat Race.
